Use of artefacts / experiences outside the classroom :

Year 1 Victorian Christmas

- Experience what a Victorian house was like before Christmas
- Experience the sights / smells etc of the kitchen
- Visit a Victorian schoolroom / parlour

Year 2 Fleetwood : Victorian Seaside holidays

- Use photographs and objects linked to seaside holidays in the past
- Have a photo taken as a Victorian child – compare with modern photography
- Meet and talk to characters from the past





Year 3 : Roman experience

- Spend a day at Hadrians wall exploring the remains of the wall and the fort at Housesteads
- Taken on a tour of the site by a Roman soldier who uses the remains to look for clues about life in the fort 2000 years ago
- Roman soldier re-enactment
- Visit the museum with actual Roman artefacts

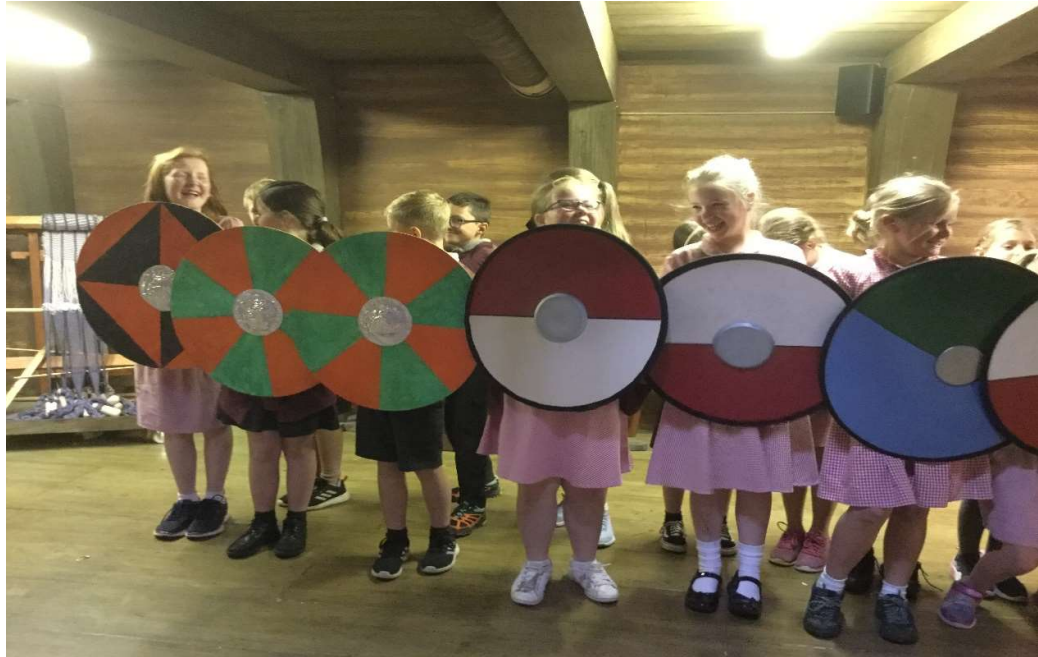




Year 4: Vikings

- We have had visitors into school to do Viking experiences using artefacts / re enactments and in 2019 we went to an afternoon workshop at Judges Lodgings including making rune badges / exploring combat by Viking warriors





Year 5: Victorian Helmshore Mill

- Object handling session – exploring real objects from a Victorian mill workers cottage – what were they used for and what clues do the objects give about life in the past?
- 2 hour session looking at working conditions in the mill and how the cotton industry changed during the industrial revolution. This includes seeing the cotton machines actually working and gives chance to explore what working in those conditions might have been like.





Year 6 : WW2 to Preston Barracks

- Explore life in the army and on the home front during WW2
- This includes higher order skills of using objects / photographs and 1st hand evidence
