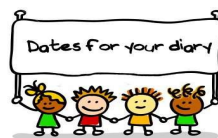

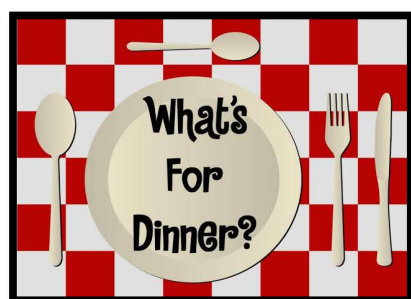

Monday- Southern style chicken goujon or vegetable finger wrap with paprika potatoes, mixed veg or BBQ beans OR Pasta tubes and tomato sauce with homemade dough balls and salad

Tuesday- Mild beef or vegetarian chilli nacho bake with mixed rice and sweetcorn OR Summer picnic lunch with vegetarian sausage roll, pasta salad, vegetable sticks and dips
